11:30-12:00	Lunch	Wash your hands (20 seconds)
12:00-1:00	Creative Time	Legos, drawing, and crafting.
1:00-1:30	Chore Time	Wipe all tables, chairs, door handles, light switches, bathroom sinks, and any other chores your parents give you to do.
1:30-2:30	Quiet Time	Reading, puzzles, word search, crossword puzzles, sudoku.
2:30-4:00	Academic Time  90 minutes= 30 work/5 min break/30 min work/5 minute break/20 min work	ELECTRONICS OK     Choose a Mystery Science lesson     Work on Math online Khan Academy(1% a day progress is typical.) or IXL     Work on IXL grammar/reading/science or social studies     If you are working in the packet, do a few pages of work a day. 9:00 ish	Bedtime	Try to keep a reasonable bedtime schedule.
